# Membership Update

After much consideration of the current situation with Covid 19, and the loss of several tournaments, the committee has agreed on the following way we shall manage our membership for 2020 & 2021.

Committee has decided to hold the AGM at the Nerang Tournament. Only registered members are allowed to vote at the AGM.

If all goes well, the 2020 QMSA State Titles will be held in Toowoomba on 3-5 October. Players must be registered members of QMSA to play the State Titles.

The committee also wants to help members and encourage participation hence the free membership, previously advised, will be applied as below.

## 1. Current members:

Those who have already joined and paid this year are eligible to vote in the AGM and play in the State Titles in October. **Their membership will carry over for 2021 without any further payment required.**

2. Previous Members who have not yet re-newed for 2020: Those who are usually members, but have not yet renewed, will need to fill in a renewal membership form and pay \$30 before the AGM to be eligible to vote. To play in the State Titles you must be a financial member. **Their membership will then carry over for 2021 without any further payment required.**

3. New members: Those who are not members but wish to join can do so by filling in the new member registration and pay \$30. They are then eligible to vote at the AGM and play in the State Titles if they have joined before those events. **Their membership will carry over for 2021 without any further payment required.**

Membership can be completed via the new QMSA Website and payment via direct bank transfer.

Forms will be available at Nerang for those who wish to join then. We can only accept cash at Nerang, not credit cards.

The statement on the WSF website dated 05.06.2020 reads as follows:

*The World Squash Federation (WSF) confirmed today that the World Masters Squash Championships – originally postponed from August 2020 due to the global COVID-19 pandemic – has been rescheduled to 15-21 August 2021.*

*Additionally, the WSF has approved the qualifying age for the postponed event, which will remain as per the original start date of the event on 23 August 2020. This ensures that those who entered this year's event still qualify for the same age group on the new dates.*



# Mature Age Squash Arrives

"DROP SHOT" — November-December Issue, 1980.

On Saturday and Sunday 13th and 14th December, 1980 a meeting was held in Sydney to form the Australian Mature Age Squash Players Association. The vital word, players, covers men and women over 35 years of age and competitions will be held on a state-wide, interstate or world wide basis.

Delegates have been appointed from each state and while each state is to be affiliated with their local state association the Australian Mature Age Squash Players Association has also requested affiliation with the Squash Rackets Association of Australia.

All states of Australia are involved except the Northern Territory where a sub-committee has been formed because of the lack of mature age players.

The Queensland issues have been lacking in their support

for the Queensland Mature Age Squash Players Association and in fact only Jenny Irving, Elva Priestley, Marion Jackman, Robyn Prentice, Ada Bell and Denise Chalmers have joined the association. Women who wish to be chosen for mature age teams must be members of the association and it is hoped that the other mature age ladies join in the near future.

It is hoped and indeed desired that the ladies consider their availability now for a 1982 tour of England, when, by that time, some progress may be made in regard to holding world titles in age groups for both men and women. At the moment there are no official age groups in the UK other than the Veterans and Vintage but the current tour by the men hopefully will rectify this situation. So ladies start planning now for March 1982 for both individual and

The current men's tour is a private tour organised by the Aust. Mature Age Squash Players Association and in 1982 the Squash Rackets Association of Aust. will endorse the tours when affiliated with the Squash Rackets Association of Aust. has been completed following acceptance of the constitution.

Correspondence has been received from England and it is certain that the Australian team will be watching the Home Veteran International Competition between England, Ireland, Scotland and Wales on 21st and 22nd March 1981. Matches will then probably be played within the next 10 days against each of these countries.

Peter Nance has been contacted in Sweden and is organising a Swedish Mature Age team to play the Australian team. New Zealand have already requested to join Australia and the Mature Age Squash in Canada are to be approached in the near future with the aim of participating in World Mature Age Competition.

On the local scene it is intended to hold tournaments in

Garden City, Gatton, Southport and Jindalee. To encourage players, it has been suggested that two handicap tournaments be held. One at Garden City and another at one of the other venues. In this way the ladies would play on handicap in the same competition as the men. After all, it is the Mature Age PLAYERS Association.

To sum up this new organisation we need more players, both men and women who are prepared to play in next year's tournaments and who wish to participate in interstate and over-seas matches as players and spectators in the future.

Start your savings plan now and prepare for an over-seas trip in 1982.

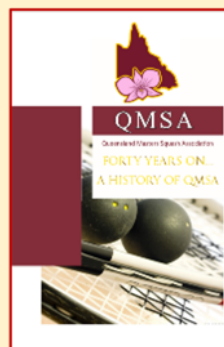

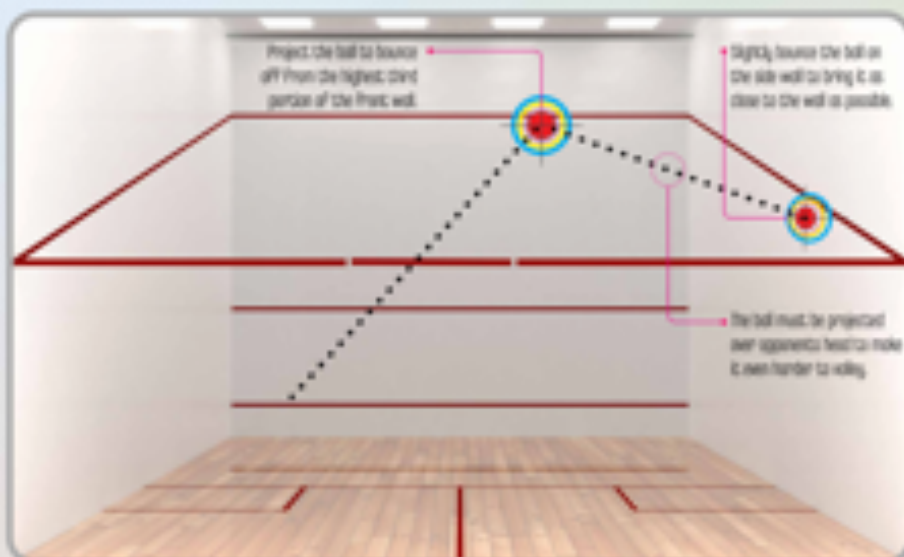


# The SQUASH Lob Serve

A lob serve is a serve in squash that is very hard to volley when done correctly. It takes advantage of the opposing upper corner of court and the height at which the ball is projected. This leaves very small room for your opponent at a very far position from the front wall.

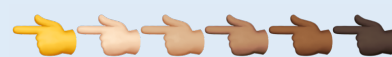
## Projecting the ball on the serve

During the serve, the ball is projected towards the highest third of the front wall and slightly bouncing from the sidewall as it reaches the opposite corner of the back wall. The height of the ball must also be constantly above the opponent's head to make it even more hard to reach.



## Overhead Power Serve

The lob serve is performed with an overhead power serve. This makes it easier to hit the ball high enough towards the direction above your opponent's head.
