Represent Australia at the World Masters in Poland 2020

23-29 August 2020

This is your opportunity to play for Australia - with a full Aussie kit to impress everyone in your local club and family, and a world travel experience that is unrivalled.

The Championships

Every two years the World Masters squash championships are held as individual events for each age group, but with an overall point score championship for the large and small nation groupings.

In 2018, the Championships were played in Charlottesville USA with over 800 competitors. The Australian team with more than 70 came second to England in the large nation's competition. We don't want that to happen again.

Am I good enough to play?

The individual championships in each age group are open to anyone to enter. In 2020, there will be local club players in each age group from Poland and surrounding European countries. If you are playing Masters competitively in your local competition or at the Australian Masters, you are certainly good enough. Plate systems apply, so you will have at least three matches, maybe many more.

Hasta La Vista the World's biggest squash club!



Of course, most of the best players in the world over 35 will be there playing as well. Charlottesville saw Australian players such as Sarah Fitz-Gerald, Brett Martin, Geoff Davenport and Sue Hillier carry on their squash careers by becoming world champion. In 2020, they could be your teammates.

Will I be part of the Team?

Points are scored depending on where you progress in the main draw, but also where you finish in the multiple plate events. For countries like Australia, with an historically good standard of squash, many of our players will find themselves in plate finals and semis with the possibility of scoring points for Australia.

With a large team, this will be our strength.

We are aiming to have over 100 players from Australia in Wroclaw in 2020. Sure, we want some of our past and present world champions to turn up and win, but we need every point to beat England, New Zealand, Canada, United States and South Africa to name a few.

In 2020, for the first time, we aim to have the Australian team staying at the one hotel and supporting each other in their individual matches. Just imagine a large group of Aussies in a major hotel in the middle of Wroclaw on long, warm, summer nights in August – let's do Australia proud.

We will also make an Australian team uniform available to order before you go – probably a playing shirt and a warm-up top. We want to be a very visible presence in the world's largest squash centre in the green and gold. And we'll tell all the other players to talk to us because we're friendly Aussies.

The Hasta La Vista Club

The venue for the World Masters in Poland is the world's largest squash centre with 32 pristine Courttech courts. This means that over a thousand matches in the week will all be played in the same centre, with the best matches showcased on the glass centre court with comfortable spectator viewing.

Wroclaw – The City

Wroclaw is a university and research city of about 600,000 people in the south-west of Poland. It is recognised by many as one of the most beautiful cities in Europe, with a historic 13th Century city centre. It is the capital of the region of Silesia, and has really only been part of modern Poland since 1945. The city has at times been part of the kingdoms of Bohemia, Prussia, Hungary and Germany.

AMSA Coordination – Our Role

The Australian Masters Squash Association, with the help of the State and Territory associations will provide some coordination to make playing for Australia in the individual championships a great social event and something you can be proud to enjoy.

We've appointed Travel Associates in Canberra (TA-CBR) as our coordinating agency. TA-CBR will have all the details of what is happening with the World Masters and work closely with the AMSA coordination team.

We have already identified a team hotel (the Sofitel Old Town) in the centre of Wroclaw and have reserved 50 rooms for the week – so we can socialise together.

Before and during the championships, we will set up an Australian social media group that will make it easy to coordinate all the action both on and off the courts. Based on past experience, there will be a number of official and unofficial social events planned for the week and the AMSA team will assist team members to book and get organised.

Making it a European Exploration

The Championships are only for one week. For some, they will want to fly directly from Australia to Wroclaw and return when play is completed. That's fine, TA-CBR can book your flights.

For most, we expect that you will want to take some time to visit other sensational parts of Europe before or after the Championships. You will be able to coordinate the flight bookings, hire cars, hotel and tours with TA-CBR, with any Travel Associates offices, or even with your own local travel agency who can also coordinate some aspects of the trip with the TA-CBR.

You might want to get a few friends together and make a travel group out of it. How about a few days in Prague before the Championships and a few days in Berlin to follow. We might even be able to organise a local hit or socialising with the local squash clubs.

Or fly into London or Paris and make your way across Europe by train, play in the Championships, and fly back out from Moscow or Minsk.

Where groups set up an itinerary, we can not only help to coordinate, we can share your travel plans with others if you want to build the size of the group to reduce costs.

The objective is to provide a flexible level of coordination and support that meets your individual needs and enables you to get the most out of playing in the Championships.

Budget

TA-CBR has looked at accommodation and flights and estimated about \$740 for the week's accommodation each on a twin-share basis with full breakfast in the Sofitel hotel in the Old Town, and about \$1,850 for the return economy airfare. That seems pretty reasonable to us for a such an amazing opportunity to play for Australia and socialise with some of the friendliest sports people you're likely to meet.

Register Your Interest Now

Even if you are thinking the Championships might be interesting, but you're not sure yet, register now.

By registering, we will provide you with updates and further details as we get closer to the Championships, so that the excitement can grow and you can imagine yourself playing in the green and gold on the Hasta La Vista courts with Aussie team mates cheering you on.

Register now and join all of us in Wroclaw in August 2020. If you haven't been to a World Masters Squash Championships before, talk to someone who has. They keep coming back – and so will you.

Following our meeting on 15 May, I am happy to advise that I have secured group accommodation at the Sofitel Wroclaw Old Town Hotel for the Australian contingent going to the World Masters Squash Championships in Wroclaw.

Airfares

The likelihood is that many participants will extend their time in Europe either prior to the championships in Wroclaw or afterwards. This essentially means that itineraries are customised to individual needs, which does not lend itself to providing a group airfare. No single airline will fly from Australia into Wroclaw. Depending on what people's movements are before/after the championships, we could use carriers such as; Qantas, Emirates, Qatar or Singapore Airlines for fares to a city closeby and then travel via road/rail to Wroclaw. Alternatively, fly on a combined fare directly into Wroclaw i.e. Singapore Airlines & Lufthansa.

Reis & James Travel Associates will of course provide advice to all participants based on their individual travel requirements.

As dates of travel are out of the system's booking range, I have prepared an estimate below of airfares based on a Singapore & Lufthansa fare into Wroclaw using fares available for August 2019. Please note the fare levels for August 2020 travel won't be available until approximately September 2019. The below should assist in providing an estimate of the cheapest fare level that may be available.

Economy Class from: \$1,815.00

Business Class from: \$6,200.00

Important Note: *The earlier individuals book the better the opportunity of getting a cheaper fare.*

Airport Transfers

Return airport transfers can be arranged as required; either on a shared coach basis or as private transfers. Costs to be advised at time of quoting according to individual requirements.



Players who will be participating in the 2019 AMSA Teams event



The QMSA Committee met in January 2019, where we discussed the upcoming AMSA Championships and more specifically the player's fee to participate in the Teams event. The Committee is mindful of the total funding that is required to host these Championships, and therefore, the Committee has unanimously decided not to subsidise the player entry fee for the Teams event for this year. The fee to participate in the Teams event is **\$70** per player, so as most QMSA players will not need to fund airfares to travel to the Gold Coast, this represents a significant saving for the player. This is a decision made for 2019 and may not reflect future AMSA Teams events.

WORLD SQUASH FEDERATION RULES UPDATE

4 THE WARM-UP

4.1 At the start of a match the players go on court together to warm up the ball for a maximum of 4 minutes. After 2 minutes the players must change sides, unless they have already done so.

4.2 The players must have equal opportunities to strike the ball. A player retaining control of the ball for an unreasonable time is warming up unfairly and Rule 15 (Conduct) must be applied.

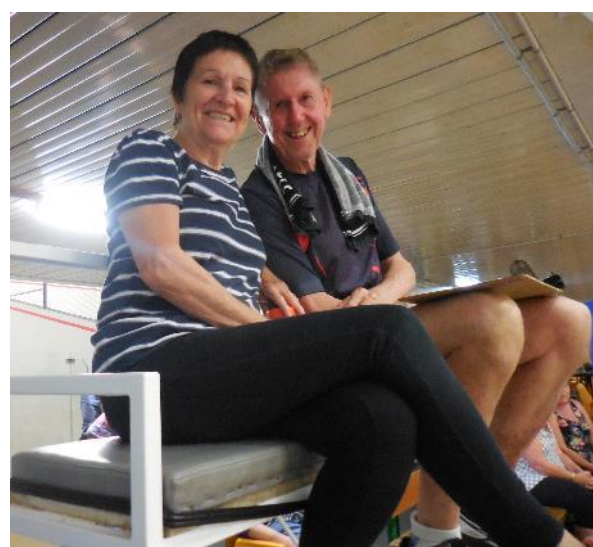

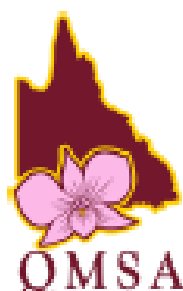
